Through Lübeck by bus: This way you can comfortably keep an eye on the big picture while driving past the most famous sights of this Hanseatic city.



Guided tours for the public

Our city guides will take you right across Lübeck's Old Town island. You will walk past the most famous sights and note that even today you can still sense the flair of Hanseatic times when you pass the red-brick witnesses to a different age.

Themed tours

Guided tour of alleys and courtyards: Walk

through the picturesque alleys and courtyards and explore these areen oases in the heart of Lübeck's Old Town!

Duration: approx. 90 minutes

Costumed tours: Dressed in historical garb, our guides will lead you through Lübeck with many

exciting tales and anecdotes from a different age.

Duration: approx. 90 minutes Prior booking required

Walks

Whether in the Schellbruch nature conservation area, along the Elbe-Lübeck canal or following the Drägerweg Trail - excursions into the countryside around Lübeck will show you Northern Germany's wonderful fauna and flora.

Double-deckers

Your city sightseeing tour by double-decker bus will take you right across the Old Town island and through the surrounding districts. It can easily be combined with a round trip of the harbour.

- From May to October
- Duration: approx. 50 minutes
- Departure from the Lower Trave (near the Holsten Gate bridge)
- Tickets can be bought on the bus
- Commentary in various languages possible

Splash bus

Partly on the water, partly on land: With the amphibious bus, you will experience your city sightseeing tour of Lübeck from many different perspectives.

- From March to December
- Duration: approx. 60 minutes
- Departure: An der Untertrave 92 near the pedestrian bridge to the Music and Congress Centre
- You can buy tickets on the bus, online and in advance from the Tourist Information Office Commentary in German only

ON THE WATER

The Trave and Wakenitz rivers and the town canal flow around the Old Town island, and they offer a wonderful opportunity to experience it from the water - on a sightseeing tour by boat or individually.

Harbour and canal tour

A relaxed boat trip around the Old Town island takes you past the traditional Old Town cityscape with its historical monuments.

- Duration: approx. 1 hour
- Providers: Cityschiffahrt H. Gabriel, Quandt-Linie, Stühff Lübecker Barkassenfahrt
- Commentary in German only

You can explore Lübeck's surroundings by bike on the most beautiful routes, either towards Travemünde by the sea or inland through the Northern countryside; here are a few suggestions.

Wakenitz boat trip

This trip on the "Amazon of the North" takes you from Lübeck to Rothenhusen on Lake Ratzeburg, through the pristine nature of the Wakenitz lowlands

- Duration: approx. 1 hour 15 minutes
- From here, you can change boats to continue your journey to Ratzeburg on Lake Ratzeburg.
- Provider: Wakenitz-Schifffahrt Quandt

Trip to Travemünde

An excursion to the sea! The MS Hanse travels along the Trave from Lübeck to Travemünde and back. Or you can take a number 30 or 40 bus or a train for part of the journey.

- Duration approx. 1.5 hours one way
- Provider: MS Hanse

Boat Now

Take the helm yourself! On the Upper Trave, you can rent electric boats without a licence and sail round the Old Town island on your own.

Bike tour Lübeck-Travemünde

You will cycle through the countryside from the Hanseatic city to the seaside resort for a distance of around 18 kilometres. A free shuttle bus will take you through the 'Herrentunnel'.

Old Salt Road

This section of the 116 kilometre Old Salt Road takes you from Lübeck along the Elbe-Lübeck canal towards Lauenburg.

Drägerweg Trail

From Lübeck, you cycle for a distance of around 18 kilometres through the Wakenitz lowlands to Rothenhusen on Lake Ratzeburg. You can buy the following bike maps at Lübeck's Tourist Information Office:

- **Bike Map Lübeck:** covers the immediate surroundings of Lübeck within a radius of 35 kilometres from Timmendorfer Strand to Lake Ratzeburg, scale 1:30,000.
- ADFC Regional Map of Lübeck and the surrounding area: extensive radius of 60 kilometres from Neustadt to Zarrentin on Lake Schaal, scale: 1:75,000
